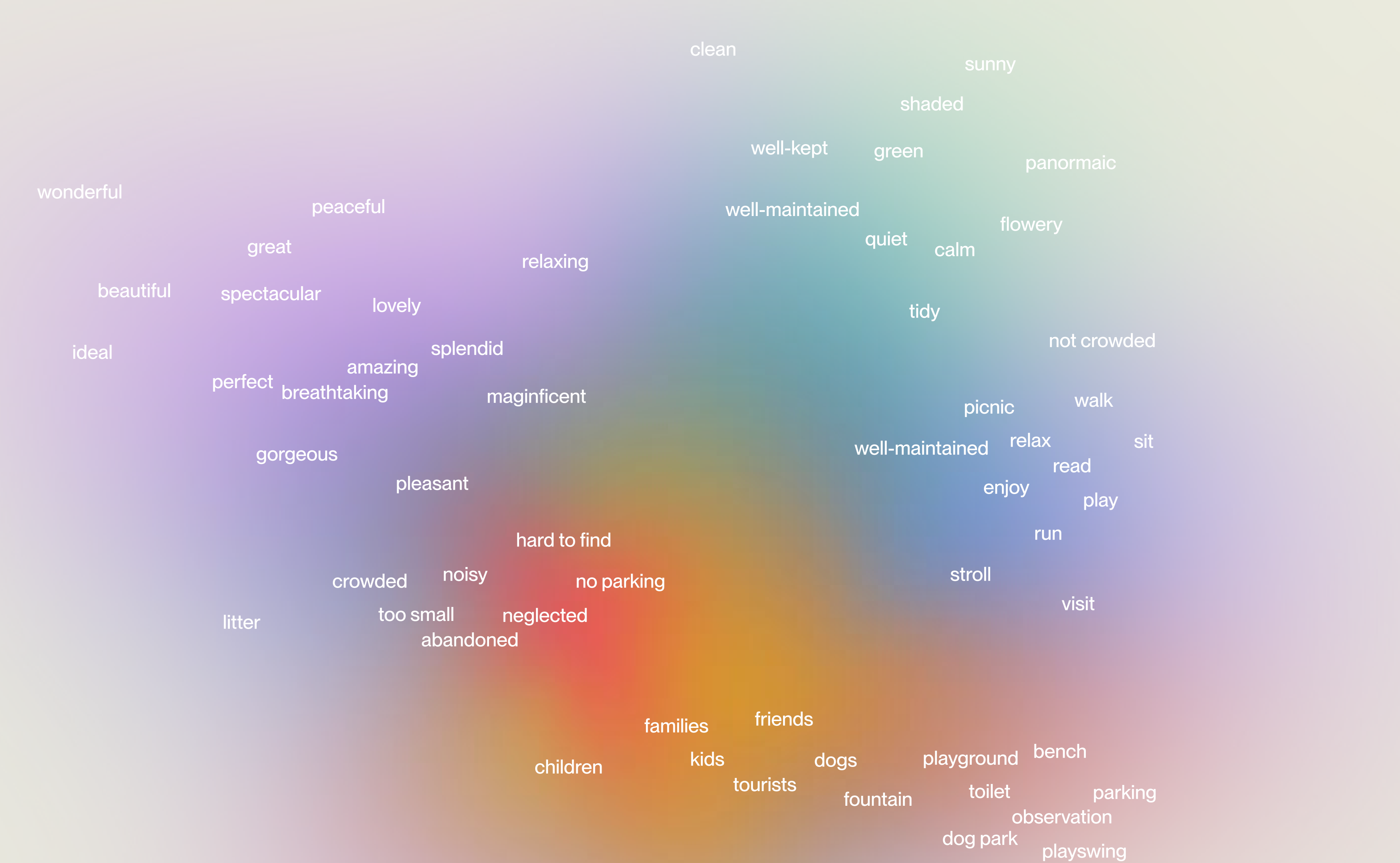


Parco Tassino

Parco Tassino is described as a quiet, well-kept park. Its defining quality is the panoramic view — over the lake, Monte Brè, and the city below — which almost every visitor mentions. The park is valued precisely for what it lacks: crowds, noise, and bustle. People come to sit, read, picnic, and let children play on the small playground. It appears in reviews as a personal discovery, a "hidden gem" and local secret. The one recurring complaint is train noise drifting up from the station below, which undercuts the natural quiet the park otherwise offers.
